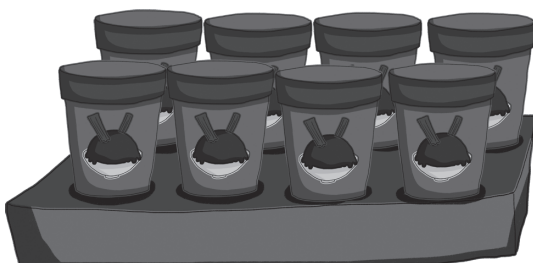
3 Tubs of chocolate ice cream are packed into boxes of 8. How many tubs are there in 46 boxes?
